THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT TAKE ADVANTAGE OF ANY SUCH DISCREPANCIES, ERRORS OR OMISSIONS BUT SHALL COMPLY WITH THE CORRECTIVE MEASURES REGARDING THE SAME PRESCRIBED BY THE ARCHITECT.
- ALL WORK AND MATERIALS SHALL BE IN FULL ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CODES AND ALL APPLICABLE LOCAL ORDINANCES, AS INDICATED IN CODES & REGULATIONS BELOW. WHERE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS EXCEED SUCH REQUIREMENTS, WITHOUT VIOLATING SUCH CODES, REGULATIONS AND ORDINANCES, CONTRACT DOCUMENTS TAKE PRECEDENCE. WHERE CODES CONFLICT, THE MORE STRINGENT SHALL APPLY.

- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SAFEGUARD AND PROTECT EXISTING WORK ON ADJACENT PRIVATE AND PUBLIC PROPERTY AND SCHOOL GROUNDS. ANY DAMAGE INCURRED DUE TO FAILURE BY THE CONTRACTOR TO PROPERLY PROTECT SUCH WORK SHALL BE REPAIRED AT THE CONRACTOR'S EXPENSE.

ELECTRICAL SPECIFICATIONS

1. GENERAL

- A. SCOPE: FURNISH ALL MATERIALS AND LABOR REQUIRED TO EXECUTE THIS WORK AS INDICATED ON DRAWING AND AS SPECIFIED, AS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE CONTRACT. ELECTRICAL WORK SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THESE MAJOR
 - 1. COMPLETE WIRING SYSTEM INCLUDING NEW CONDUITS, NEW WIRES, NEW DEVICES FOR A COMPLETE POWER OF IRRIGATION SONTROL SYSTEM.
 - 2. TEST OF ENTIRE SYSTEM AND WORK.

2. EXISTING CONDITIONS AND SITE INSPECTION

- A. CONTRACTOR SHALL PERFORM AN ON-SITE INSPECTION PRIOR TO THE SUBMISSION OF HIS BID, WHICH SHALL INCLUDE A CAREFUL EXAMINATION OF THE EXISTING BUILDING AND HE SHALL THOROUGHLY FAMILIARIZE HIMSELF WITH THE WORKING CONDITION AND EXACT NATURE OF NEW AND EXISTING ELECTRICAL WORK. BY THE ACT OF SUBMITTING A BID, HE ACKNOWLEDGE FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR FURNISHING A COMPLETE AND FUNCTIONAL SYSTEM FOR BOTH THE NEW AND/OR EXISTING ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS. NO CHANGES IN CONTRACT WILL BE MADE TO ACCOMODATE OR ALLOW EXTRA FUNDS FOR ANY OMISSION WHICH RESULT FROM A FAILURE TO THOROUGHLY MAKE THE EXAMINATION.
- B. CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE WITH BUILDING OWNER ALL CORE DRILLING AND/OR SAW CUTTING PRIOR TO START OF WORK. CONTRACTOR SHALL CAREFULLY VERIFY ALL CORE DRILLS AND/OR SAW CUTTING, ETC., REQUIRED IN EXISTING SLABS FOR POSSIBLE CONFLICTS. ANY CONFLICTS SHALL BE BROUGHT TO ARCHITECT'S ATTENTION.

3. CODE COMPLIANCE

- A. ALL ELECTRICAL WORK SHALL BE INSTALLED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS, ELECTRICAL REGULATIONS OF THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL AND ALL OTHER GOVERNING CODES.
- 4. PERMITS AND FEES

SECURE AND PAY FOR ALL PERMITS AND FEES NECESSARY FOR EXECUTION AND COMPLETION OF ELECTRICAL WORK.

5. MATERIAL

A. ALL EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS SHALL BE NEW AND LISTED BY THE UNDER—WRITER'S LABORATORIES, INC. MANUFACTURED IN ACCORDANCE WITH U.L., NEMA, ANSI OR IEEE STANDARDS, AND APPROVED BY ALL AUTHORITIES HAVING JURISDICTION.

6. GROUNDING

- A. ALL ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT, DEVICES AND SYSTEMS SHALL BE GROUNDED IN STRICT COMPLIANCE WITH NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE AND ALL STATE AND LOCAL CODES. A GROUNDING CONDUCTOR SHALL BE INSTALLED IN ALL NEW BRANCH CIRCUIT WIRING.
- 7. ALL CONDUCTORS SHALL BE COPPER TYPE "THWN"/"THHN" RATED AT 600 VOLTS, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
- 8. ALL CONDUITS EXPOSED SHALL BE RIGID GALVANIZED STEEL (RGS).
- 9. ALL CONDUITS CONCEALED SHALL BE ELECTRIC METALLIC TUBING (EMT).
- 10. UNDERGROUND CONDUITS SHALL BE SCHEDULE 40 PVC.
- 11. FLEXIBLE STEEL CONDUIT SHALL NOT BE USED.
- 12. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VISIT THE EXISTING SCHOOL AND VERIFY ALL ELECTRICAL CONDITIONS THAT MAY AFFECT HIS BID AND HE SHALL INCLUDE ALL SUCH COSTS WHEN SUBMITTING HIS BID PROPOSAL. NO EXTRAS WILL BE ALLOWED IF THE CONTRACTOR DID NOT VISIT THE EXISTING JOB SITE AND TAKE INTO CONSIDER—ATION ALL EXISTING ELECTRICAL CONDITIONS.
- 13. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL EXERCISE CARE AND PRUDENCE WHEN RUNNING CONDUIT ON OR IN EXISTING BUILDINGS WHERE INDICATED. ALL DAMAGES INCURRED BY AN ELECTRICAL WORK SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR.
- 14. WHERE CONDUITS ARE RUN EXPOSED ON ROOF OR COVERED WALK, USE 2" X 4" REDWOOD BLOCKS AT 10'-0" ON CENTER. USE MASTIC TO SECURE THE BLOCKS TO THE ROOF OR CANOPY, NO SCREWS ALLOWED.
- 15. REWORK OF EXISTING PANELBOARD

WHERE A NEW CIRCUIT BREAKER IS CALLED FOR WITHIN EXISTING PANELBOARD, THEY SHALL MATCH EXISTING IN ALL ASPECTS.

16. SCHEDULE OF WORK

ANY WORK TO BE PERFORMED IN EXISTING BUILDINGS DURING SCHOOL SESSIONS MUST BE PLANNED BY THE CONTRACTOR IN ADVANCE. THE SCHEDULING SHALL BE DONE IN COOPERATION WITH THE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL WHO WILL MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE CONTRACTOR FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF THIS WORK, PORTIONS OF BUILDING WHICH MAY NORMALLY BE IN USE.

17. CONTINUITY OF EXISTING ELECTRICAL SYSTEMS

- A. THE ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR MAINTENANCE OF POWER, LIGHT COMMUNICATION, SIGNAL, FIRE ALARM AND SECURITY SYSTEM SERVICE TO THE EXISTING BUILDINGS.
- B. REFRIGERATION MOTORS SHALL BE KEPT OPERATING AT ALL TIMES, EXCEPT FOR PERIODS OF TIME NOT AGGREGATING MORE THAN TWO HOURS IN ANY ONE DAY AND DURING THE VACATION PERIOD. NOTIFY THE DISTRICT BEFORE DISCONNECTING REFRIGERATION MOTORS.

18. SCHEDULED POWER OUTAGES

COORDINATE AND SCHEDULE ALL OUTAGES WITH THE PRINCIPAL AND SCHOOL DISTRICT'S DIRECTOR OF MAINTENANCE PRIOR TO ANY AND ALL OUTAGES.

19. PANELBOARD SHALL BE GENERAL ELECTRIC A—SERIES 11 TO MATCH EXISTING POWER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM EQUIPMENT.




